- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 41.001, Election Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (f) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to:
- 8 (1) a runoff election;
- 9 (2) an election for the issuance or assumption of
- 10 bonds for any purpose authorized by law relating to public schools
- or colleges or the levy of a tax for the maintenance of a public
- 12 school or college, if the governing body of the political
- 13 subdivision having jurisdiction of the public school or college
- issuing or assuming the bonds or levying the tax:
- 15 (A) by resolution, order, or ordinance, finds
- 16 that holding the election on a date other than a uniform election
- 17 date is in the public interest[, which finding is conclusive and
- 18 <u>incontestable</u>]; [and]
- 19 (B) the election is the only election of the type
- 20 described by this subdivision held by that political subdivision on
- 21 a date other than a uniform election date during the state fiscal
- 22 biennium; and
- (C) makes an application with the secretary of
- 24 state to hold the election on that date and the secretary of state

- 1 finds that holding the election on that date is in the public

- 3 (3) an election to resolve a tie vote;
- 4 (4) an election held under an order of a court or other
- 5 tribunal;
- 6 (5) an emergency election ordered under Section

- 8 (6) an expedited election to fill a vacancy in the

- 10 (7) an election held under a statute that expressly
- 11 provides that the requirement of Subsection (a) does not apply to

- 13 (f) The secretary of state may adopt procedures as necessary
- 14 to implement Subsection (b)(2)(C).
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
