3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Title 6, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
5	amended by adding Chapter 125A to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 125A. PRIVATE NUISANCE
7	Sec. 125A.001. PREEXISTING CONDITIONS OR CIRCUMSTANCES. A
8	claimant may not bring an action for private nuisance based on
9	interference with the use and enjoyment of real property acquired
10	by the claimant after the defendant became lawfully engaged in the
11	activities causing the conditions and circumstances claimed to
12	cause the interference complained of if:
13	(1) those activities continue to be lawful; and
14	(2) those conditions and circumstances have existed
15	substantially unchanged since the claimant acquired the property.
16	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
17	to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
18	this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
19	of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
20	date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
