- 2 relating to the exclusion of certain materials from a reservation
- 3 of minerals to the state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 53, Natural Resources
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 53.002 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 53.002. EXCLUSION OF CERTAIN MATERIALS FROM
- 8 RESERVATION OF MINERALS TO STATE. Unless otherwise expressly
- 9 provided by statute or by a deed, patent, or other grant from the
- 10 state, a reservation of minerals to the state does not include sand,
- 11 gravel, caliche, rock, or other similar materials.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act applies to a reservation of minerals to
- 13 the state under a conveyance that is made before, on, or after the
- 14 effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
