- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1701.354(d), Occupations Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) The commission may waive the [requirement that a
- 9 constable or deputy constable complete the] instruction
- 10 requirements under [required by] this section [if]:
- 11 (1) for a deputy constable, if a constable requests a
- waiver for the deputy constable based on a representation that the
- 13 <u>deputy constable's duty assignment does not involve civil process</u>
- 14 responsibilities; or
- 15 (2) for a constable or deputy constable, if the
- 16 constable or deputy constable requests a waiver because of
- 17 hardship [+] and
- 18  $\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$  the commission determines that a hardship
- 19 exists.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
