5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 1701.354(d), Occupations Code, is
7	amended to read as follows:
8	(d) The commission may waive the [requirement that a
9	constable or deputy constable complete the] instruction
10	requirements under [required by] this section [if]:
11	(1) for a deputy constable, if a constable requests a
12	waiver for the deputy constable based on a representation that the
13	deputy constable's duty assignment does not involve civil process
14	responsibilities; or
15	(2) for a constable or deputy constable, if the
16	constable or deputy constable requests a waiver because of
17	hardship[+] and
18	$\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ the commission determines that a hardship
19	exists.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
