A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to providing the national free or reduced-price breakfast

- 3 and lunch program to a greater number of public school students.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Agriculture Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 12.039 to read as follows:
- Sec. 12.039. SCHOOL BREAKFAST AND LUNCH PROGRAM. (a) The
- 8 <u>department shall:</u>
- 9 (1) support making free breakfast and lunch available
- 10 to all schoolchildren whenever it is economically feasible to do
- 11 so;
- 12 (2) assist school districts in determining whether it
- is economically feasible for a district to provide free breakfast
- 14 and lunch in accordance with the national free or reduced-price
- 15 breakfast and lunch program established under 42 U.S.C. Section
- 16 1751 et seq. to all students enrolled at each campus in the
- 17 district; and
- 18 (3) encourage school districts to make free breakfast
- 19 and lunch available to all students enrolled at each campus in the
- 20 district whenever it is economically feasible to do so.
- (b) The department, the Texas Education Agency, and the
- 22 Health and Human Services Commission shall ensure that applicable
- 23 <u>information maintained by each entity is used on at least a</u>
- 24 quarterly basis to identify children who are categorically eligible

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- 1 for free meals under the national free or reduced-price breakfast
- 2 and lunch program. In complying with this subsection, the
- 3 department, agency, and commission shall use information that
- 4 corresponds to the months of the year in which enrollment in the
- 5 food stamp program is customarily higher than average.
- 6 (c) The department shall determine the feasibility of
- 7 <u>establishing a process under which school districts verify student</u>
- 8 <u>eligibility for the national free or reduced-price breakfast and</u>
- 9 lunch program through a direct verification process that uses
- information maintained under the food stamp and Medicaid programs,
- as authorized by 42 U.S.C. Section 1758(b)(3), as amended by
- 12 Section 105(a) of the Child Nutrition and WIC Reauthorization Act
- of 2004 (Pub. L. No. 108-265), and 7 C.F.R. Sections 245.6a(a)(1)
- and (3) and 245.6a(b)($\underline{3}$). If the department determines the process
- 15 described by this subsection is feasible, the department may
- 16 <u>implement the process.</u>
- 17 (d) To enable the department to make the determination
- 18 required by Subsection (c), the department, the Texas Education
- 19 Agency, and the Health and Human Services Commission shall conduct
- 20 a joint study. Not later than September 1, 2006, the department,
- 21 the Texas Education Agency, and the Health and Human Services
- 22 Commission shall submit a joint report to the legislature regarding
- 23 the results of the study required by this subsection. This
- subsection expires January 1, 2007.
- 25 SECTION 2. Section 12.039(b), Agriculture Code, as added by
- this Act, applies beginning with the 2005-2006 school year.
- 27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
