21	(b) At any time when the legislature is in session, on
22	application of a member of the legislature who has been called, by
23	subpoena or other method, to testify as a witness or to give a

- 1 potential witness by a party to a matter, the court or other officer
- 2 before whom the matter is pending shall as provided by this section
- 3 excuse the member from being compelled to testify as a witness or to
- 4 give a deposition.
- 5 (c) A member of the legislature seeking to be excused under
- 6 this section must file a request for the excuse with the court or
- 7 other officer before whom the matter is pending. On receipt of the
- 8 request, the court or other officer shall excuse the member from
- 9 being compelled to give testimony or a deposition in the proceeding
- 10 until a time and place agreed to by the person or until a date not
- 11 earlier than the fifth day after the date the legislative session
- 12 ends.
- 13 (d) This section does not diminish or affect any immunity or
- 14 privilege of a member of the legislature under other law, including
- the constitution or common law.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
