- 16 (c) At any time when the legislature is in session, on
- 17 application of a member of the legislature who has been called, by
- 18 subpoena or other method, to testify as a witness or to give a
- 19 deposition, or who in discovery has been named as a potential
- 20 witness by a party, the court in which the suit is pending shall
- 21 excuse the person from being compelled to testify as a witness or to
- 22 give a deposition as provided by this section.

- 1 receipt of the request, the court shall excuse the member from being

- 6 privilege of a member of the legislature under other law, including
