4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 487, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 487.354 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 487.354. SUPPLEMENTAL QUESTIONNAIRE FOR EVALUATION OF
8	COLONIAS AND OTHER ECONOMICALLY DISTRESSED AREAS. (a) In this
9	section:
10	(1) "Colonia" means any identifiable unincorporated
11	community, or an identifiable community annexed by a municipality
12	and eligible for assistance as described by Section 43.907(b),
13	Local Government Code, that:
14	(A) is located within 150 miles of the
15	international border of this state in a county that is eligible to
16	receive financial assistance from the community development block
17	grant colonia fund under this subchapter, as identified by office
18	rule;
19	(B) is determined by the office to be a colonia on
20	the basis of objective criteria, including lack of potable water
21	supply, lack of adequate sewage systems, and lack of decent, safe,

and sanitary housing; and
