2 SECTION 5. (a) A person may not enter into an informal 3 marriage after the effective date of this Act. An informal marriage 4 entered into before the effective date of this Act is governed by 5 the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, 6 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

7 (b) An informal marriage entered into before the effective 8 date of this Act may be proved as provided by Section 2.401, Family 9 Code, as that section existed immediately before the effective date 10 of this Act.
