- 1 (4) undertake cooperative and joint procurement of
 2 road materials with counties under <u>Texas Building and Procurement</u>
 3 [<u>General Services</u>] Commission procedures.
- 4 <u>(b) Chapter 2175, Government Code, does not apply to the</u> 5 distribution of assistance by the department under this section.
- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (a)(4), this section

 does not authorize the department to purchase materials or

 equipment for a county.
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
