4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1601.303, Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1601.303. ISSUANCE OF BARBERSHOP PERMIT. The board
8	shall issue a barbershop permit to an applicant if:
9	(1) the applicant <u>is an owner of the shop</u> [holds a
10	Class A barber certificate;
11	[(2) the applicant has practiced barbering for at
12	<pre>least 12 months]; and</pre>
13	(2) $[(3)]$ the shop meets the minimum health standards
14	for barbershops set by the board and <u>complies with</u> all other rules
15	of the board.
16	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
17	to an application for a barbershop permit filed under Chapter 1601,
18	Occupations Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. An
19	application for a permit filed before that date is governed by the
20	law in effect at the time the application was filed, and the former
21	law is continued in effect for that purpose.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
