1-7 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to designation of Farm-to-Market Road 68 in Fannin County
1-10 as Speaker Jimmy Turman Road.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.061 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.061. SPEAKER JIMMY TURMAN ROAD. (a)
1-15 Farm-to-Market Road 68 in Fannin County is designated as Speaker
1-16 Jimmy Turman Road.

1-17 (b) The department shall design and construct markers
1-18 indicating the road number, the designation as Speaker Jimmy Turman
1-19 Road, and any other appropriate information.

1-20 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the department
1-21 shall erect a marker at each end of the road and at appropriate
1-22 intermediate sites along the road.

1-23 (d) The department is not required to design, construct, or
1-24 erect a marker required by this section unless a grant or donation
1-25 of private funds is made to the department to cover the cost of the
1-26 design, construction, and erection of the marker.

1-27 (e) Money received under Subsection (d) shall be deposited
1-28 to the credit of the state highway fund.

1-29 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
