- 4 SECTION 1. Section 42.001, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subdivision (9) to read as follows:
- 6 (9) "Nonresident landowner" means a person who is a
- 7 nonresident who owns real property in this state.
- 8 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 42.002, Parks and
- 9 Wildlife Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 42.002. RESIDENT OR NONRESIDENT LANDOWNER LICENSE
- 11 REQUIRED; EXEMPTION.
- SECTION 3. Sections 42.002(a) and (b), Parks and Wildlife
- 13 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) Except as provided by Subsections (b) and (c) of this
- 15 section, no resident or nonresident landowner may hunt any bird or
- 16 animal in this state without having acquired a hunting license.
- 17 (b) A resident or nonresident landowner possessing a valid
- 18 [resident] alligator hunter's license, [resident] trapper's
- 19 license, or fur-bearing animal propagation permit is not required
- 20 to have a license issued under this section to take or possess the
- 21 species covered by the license or permit.
- SECTION 4. Section 42.0021, Parks and Wildlife Code, is

- Sec. 42.0021. LIFETIME RESIDENT OR NONRESIDENT LANDOWNER

- 2 nonresident landowners of this state a lifetime resident or

- 4 SECTION 5. Sections 42.005(a) and (b), Parks and Wildlife
- 5 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) No nonresident in this state may hunt a mule deer,
- 7 white-tailed deer, turkey, pronghorn antelope, or desert bighorn
- 8 sheep in this state without first having acquired a general

- 11 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (f), no nonresident may

- SECTION 7. Sections 42.012(a) and (b), Parks and Wildlife

- license is \$8 or an amount set by the commission, whichever amount

- 26 (b) The commission may set a lower fee or waive the fee or

- 4 The commission shall waive the fee for a qualified disabled

- 6 SECTION 8. Section 42.0121, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 42.0121. LIFETIME RESIDENT <u>OR NONRESIDENT LANDOWNER</u>
- 9 HUNTING LICENSE FEE. The fee for a lifetime resident or
- 10 <u>nonresident landowner</u> hunting license is \$300 or an amount set by
- 11 the commission, whichever amount is more.
- 12 SECTION 9. Section 42.0175(a), Parks and Wildlife Code, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 (a) A license issued under this chapter, other than a
- 15 lifetime resident or nonresident landowner hunting license or a
- 16 nonresident five-day special hunting license is valid only during
- 17 the yearly period for which the license is issued without regard to
- 18 the date on which a license is acquired. Each yearly period begins
- on September 1 or on another date set by the commission and extends
- 20 through August 31 of the next year or another date set by the
- 21 commission. A license issued under this chapter other than a
- 22 nonresident five-day special hunting license that is issued before
- 23 September 1 or another date set by the commission and does not
- 24 expire until August 31 of the next year or another date set by the
- 25 commission is valid from the date of issuance through August 31 of
- 26 the following year or another date set by the commission. The
- commission by rule may set the amount of a license fee for a license

- 1 issued during a transition period at an amount lower than
- 2 prescribed in this chapter and provide for a license term for a
- 3 transition period that is shorter or longer than a year.
- 4 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
