- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 252.043, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (d-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (d-1), the [The]
- 9 contract must be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder if the
- 10 competitive sealed bidding requirement applies to the contract for
- 11 construction of:
- 12 (1) highways, roads, streets, bridges, utilities,
- 13 water supply projects, water plants, wastewater plants, water and
- 14 wastewater distribution or conveyance facilities, wharves, docks,
- 15 airport runways and taxiways, drainage projects, or related types
- of projects associated with civil engineering construction; or
- 17 (2) buildings or structures that are incidental to
- 18 projects that are primarily civil engineering construction
- 19 projects.
- 20 (d-1) A contract for construction of a project described by
- 21 Subsection (d) that requires an expenditure of \$1.5 million or less
- 22 may be awarded using the competitive sealed proposal procedure
- prescribed by Section 271.116.
- SECTION 2. Sections 271.116(a) and (c), Local Government

- 1 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) In selecting a contractor through competitive sealed
- 3 <u>proposals</u> for construction, rehabilitation, alteration, or repair
- 4 services for a facility or for construction of a project to which
- 5 <u>Section 252.043(d-1) applies</u> [through competitive sealed
- 6 proposals], a governmental entity shall follow the procedures
- 7 prescribed by this section.
- 8 (c) The governmental entity shall provide or contract for,
- 9 independently of the contractor, the inspection services, the
- 10 testing of construction materials engineering, and the
- 11 verification testing services necessary for acceptance of the
- 12 facility or project by the governmental entity. The governmental
- 13 entity shall select those services for which it contracts in
- 14 accordance with Section 2254.004, Government Code, and shall
- identify them in the request for proposals.
- 16 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
