4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 11, Parks and Wildlife
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 11.0262 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 11.0262. CERTAIN GRATUITIES AUTHORIZED. (a) An
8	employee of the state parks division of the department may accept a
9	gratuity if:
10	(1) the employee, as a primary job duty, serves food or
11	beverages in a restaurant, cafeteria, or other food service
12	establishment located within a state park and owned and operated by
13	the department;
14	(2) the gratuity is offered by a customer of the
15	restaurant, cafeteria, or other food service establishment in
16	appreciation of being served food or beverages by the employee;
17	(3) the department has designated the employee as an
18	employee authorized to accept a gratuity; and
19	(4) the employee reports the gratuity in accordance
20	with commission rules.
21	(b) The commission may adopt rules necessary to implement
22	this section.
23	SECTION 2. Section 36.10, Penal Code, is amended by adding

1	Subsection (d) to read as follows:
2	(d) Section 36.08 (Gift to Public Servant) does not apply to
3	a gratuity accepted and reported in accordance with Section
4	11.0262, Parks and Wildlife Code. Section 36.09 (Offering Gift to
5	Public Servant) does not apply to a gratuity that is offered in
6	accordance with Section 11.0262, Parks and Wildlife Code.
7	SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 572, Government Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 572.061 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 572.061. CERTAIN GRATUITIES AUTHORIZED. This
10	subchapter does not prohibit the acceptance of a gratuity that is
11	accepted and reported in accordance with Section 11.0262, Parks and
12	Wildlife Code.
13	SECTION 4. The change in law made by Section 36.10(d), Penal
14	Code, applies to a criminal action with respect to an offense under
15	Section 36.08 or 36.09, Penal Code, committed before, on, or after
16	the effective date of this Act, except that a final conviction for
17	an offense under one of those provisions that exists on the
18	effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act.
19	SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
