- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Rick Noriega
- 6 Military Assistance Act.
- 7 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 54.215 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 54.215. MEMBERS OF TEXAS NATIONAL GUARD. (a) In this
- 10 section, "tuition and fees" has the meaning assigned by Section
- 11 54.209.
- 12 (b) The governing board of an institution of higher
- 13 education shall exempt from the payment of tuition and fees a
- 14 resident of this state enrolled as a student at the institution who
- is a member of the Texas National Guard.
- 16 (c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
- 17 adopt:
- 18 <u>(1) rules governing the granting or denial of an</u>
- 19 exemption under this section, including rules relating to the
- 20 determination of eligibility for an exemption; and
- 21 (2) a uniform application form for an exemption under
- 22 this section.
- 23 SECTION 3. Chapter 56, Education Code, is amended by adding
- 24 Subchapter G to read as follows:

1	SUBCHAPTER G. ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
2	Sec. 56.101. ADDITIONAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR MEMBERS OF
3	TEXAS NATIONAL GUARD. (a) Each institution of higher education
4	shall establish a program that provides reimbursement for the cost
5	of required textbooks and similar required course materials to
6	students of the institution who receive a tuition and fee exemption
7	under Section 54.215.
8	(b) To receive a reimbursement, a student must apply for the
9	reimbursement and provide proof of the expenditures for which
10	reimbursement is sought.
11	(c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall
12	include funding for the program in its funding formulas under
13	Section 61.059.
14	SECTION 4. Section 431.090, Government Code, is amended by
15	adding Subsection (c-1) to read as follows:
16	(c-1) A person is not eligible for tuition assistance under
17	this section for any semester or other academic term for which the
18	person is exempted under Section 54.215, Education Code, from the
19	payment of tuition and fees.
20	SECTION 5. Chapter 431, Government Code, is amended by
21	adding Subchapter K to read as follows:
22	SUBCHAPTER K. LOANS TO NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS CALLED
23	TO ACTIVE DUTY
24	Sec. 431.201. LOAN PROGRAM. The adjutant general shall
25	create a program to provide interest-free loans to support members
26	of the Texas National Guard who are called to federal active duty

and their families.

- 1 Sec. 431.202. NATIONAL GUARD TEMPORARY ASSISTANCE ACCOUNT.
- 2 (a) The national guard temporary assistance account is an account
- 3 in the general revenue fund.
- 4 (b) The money in the account may be appropriated only for
- 5 the purpose of making loans under this subchapter.
- 6 (c) The adjutant general shall deposit to the credit of the
- 7 account all loan payments made by a member of the Texas National
- 8 Guard for a loan under this subchapter.
- 9 Sec. 431.203. GIFTS AND GRANTS. The commission may solicit
- 10 and accept gifts and grants from any source, including any
- 11 governmental entity, any private or public corporation, and any
- 12 other person, for the purposes of this subchapter. The commission
- 13 shall deposit a gift or grant to the credit of the national guard
- 14 temporary assistance account.
- Sec. 431.204. RULES. The adjutant general shall adopt
- 16 rules as necessary to administer the loan program, including rules
- 17 relating to the application procedure, financial qualifications,
- 18 loan repayment, and default.
- 19 SECTION 6. The heading to Subchapter G, Chapter 431,
- 20 Government Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 21 SUBCHAPTER G. DISABILITY OR DEATH IN THE LINE OF [MILITARY] DUTY
- SECTION 7. Subchapter G, Chapter 431, Government Code, is
- 23 amended by adding Section 431.102 to read as follows:
- Sec. 431.102. COMPENSATION FOR DEATH OF MEMBER ON ACTIVE
- 25 DUTY. (a) In this section, "heirs" has the meaning assigned by
- 26 Section 3, Texas Probate Code.
- 27 (b) The state shall pay \$100,000 to the heirs of a member of

- 1 the Texas National Guard who dies while on federal active duty. If
- 2 there is more than one heir, the surviving heirs are each entitled
- 3 to a pro rata share of the payment.
- 4 (c) The adjutant general shall administer this section and
- 5 prescribe forms and adopt rules necessary to implement the section,
- 6 including rules and procedures for making or proving a claim, or
- 7 appealing a decision on a claim.
- 8 SECTION 8. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 9 section, Section 54.215, Education Code, as added by this Act,
- 10 Subchapter G, Chapter 56, Education Code, as added by this Act, and
- 11 Section 431.090(c-1), Government Code, as added by this Act, take
- 12 effect beginning with the 2006 fall semester.
- 13 (b) Not later than January 1, 2006, the Texas Higher
- 14 Education Coordinating Board shall adopt rules and forms for the
- administration of Section 54.215, Education Code, as added by this
- 16 Act.
- 17 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
