9	systems. The term does include services over converged networks.		
10	SECTION 2. Section 2054.1185, Government Code, is hereby		
11	repealed.		
12	SECTION 3. Section 2170.003, Government Code, is amended to		
13	read as follows:		
14	Section 2170.003. OWNERSHIP OR LEASE OF NECESSARY		
15	EQUIPMENT. (a) The department may own, lease, or lease-purchase		
16	in accordance with Chapters 2155, 2156, 2157, and 2158 any and all		
17	of the facilities or equipment necessary to provide		
18	telecommunications services. <u>The department may acquire</u>		
19	telecommunications services without competitive bid from the		
20	Lonestar Education and Research Network (LEARN) or its successors		
21	for the purposes established in subsection (b).		
22	(b) During an emergency, a single node failure or a system wide		
23	failure of the consolidated telecommunications system, the		
24	department may divert telecommunications services traffic to LEARN		

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to avoid service interruption. Upon resolution of the emergency 1 2 and upon determination that the consolidated telecommunications system is operational, traffic will be diverted back to the 3 consolidated telecommunications system. The department may also 4 use LEARN for the purposes of latency tolerant date transfer of 5 files to or from a consolidated state data center established and 6 7 operated by the department. The LEARN shall be exclusively used by 8 the department only for the purposes set out in this section. 9 SECTION 4. Section 2054.021, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 10 Section 2054.021(d). An ex officio member may designate the 11 12 information resources manager or another senior manager of the member's agency to serve in the member's place. 13 SECTION 5. Section 771.031, Health and Safety Code, is 14 15 amended by amending Subsection (b) to read as follows: (b) the following individuals serve as nonvoting ex officio 16 17 members: (1) the executive director of the Public Utility 18 19 Commission of Texas, or an individual designated by the executive director; 20 (2) the executive director of the [General Services 21 Commission] Department of Information Resources, or an individual 22 designated by the executive director; and 23 24 (3) the commissioner of public health, or an 25 individual who has responsibility for the poison control network 26 designated by the commissioner. The department may contract for use of the consolidated 4 telecommunications system with: 5 (1) each house of the legislature; 6 (2) a legislative agency; 7 an agency that is not a state agency as defined by (3) Section 2151.002 8 9 (4) a political subdivision, including a county, municipality, or district; [and] 10 (5) a private institution of 11 higher education accredited by a recognized accrediting agency, as defined by 12 Section 61.003, Education Code, that: 13 14 (A) engages in distance learning, as defined by 15 Section 57.021, Utilities Code, and (B) receives federal funds for distance learning 16 17 initiatives; and (6) a private business or other entity that serves a 18 19 state agency through an existing contract for services in support of the core mission of the state agency, where: 20 21 (a) the contracted entity's use of the consolidated telecommunications system would result in cost savings to the state 22 agency under the related service contract, and 23 24 (b) the department would contract with the private business or other entity only because of a telecommunications network 25 26 consolidation project between the state agency and the department.
