## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to equal employment opportunity reports.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2052.003, Government Code, is amended by
5	amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as
6	follows:
7	(a) A state agency that sends to the <u>Texas Workforce</u>
8	<u>Commission civil rights division [governor]</u> an annual report on
9	equal employment opportunities with the agency shall include in the
10	statistical information of the report information relating to the
11	number of:
12	(1) individuals with disabilities whom the agency
13	employs; and
14	(2) individuals for whom state or federal guidelines
15	encourage a more equitable balance whom the agency employs.
16	(d) Notwithstanding any other law, equal employment
17	opportunity reports and personnel policy statements required to be
18	filed with the governor shall be filed with the Texas Workforce
19	Commission civil rights division and a report required to be
20	compiled by the governor based on those equal opportunity reports
21	and personnel policy statements and filed with the legislature
22	shall be compiled by the Texas Workforce Commission civil rights
23	division and filed with the governor and the legislature. The
24	report may be made separately or as a part of any other biennial

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## 1 <u>report to the legislature.</u>

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
