A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT
<pre>relating to equal employment opportunity reports. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 2052.003, Government Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:</pre>
(a) A state agency that sends to the <u>Texas Workforce</u> <u>Commission civil rights division</u> [governor] an annual report on equal employment opportunities with the agency shall include in the statistical information of the report information relating to the number of:
<pre>(1) individuals with disabilities whom the agency employs; and</pre>
(a) Not later than <u>November 1</u> [the seventh day] of each [calendar] year, [excluding legal holidays and weekends,] each state agency shall report equal employment opportunity information for the preceding <u>fiscal</u> [calendar] year to the commission as required by this subchapter. The report must be made in the form prescribed by the commission and include information compiled on a monthly basis. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act takes effect september 1, 2005.
