- 4 SECTION 1. Section 39.151(a), Utilities Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) A power region must establish one or more independent
- 7 organizations to perform the following functions:
- 8 (1) ensure access to the transmission and distribution
- 9 systems for all buyers and sellers of electricity on
- 10 nondiscriminatory terms;
- 11 (2) ensure the reliability and adequacy of the
- 12 regional electrical network;
- 13 (3) ensure that information relating to a customer's
- 14 choice of retail electric provider is conveyed in a timely manner to
- the persons who need that information; [and]
- 16 (4) ensure that electricity production and delivery
- 17 are accurately accounted for among the generators and wholesale
- buyers and sellers in the region; and
- 19 <u>(5) ensure that transmission congestion costs are</u>
- 20 equally spread to all electric consumers in the region.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
