A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to funding for career and technology programs in public 3 schools.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 42.154(a) and (c), Education Code, are 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) For each full-time equivalent student in average daily 8 attendance in an approved career and technology education program 9 in grades <u>seven</u> [<u>nine</u>] through 12<u>, including a</u> [or in] career and 10 technology education <u>program</u> [programs] for students with 11 disabilities [in grades seven through 12], a district is entitled 12 to an annual allotment equal to the adjusted basic allotment 13 multiplied by a weight of 1.35.

(c) Funds allocated under this section, other than an indirect cost allotment established under State Board of Education rule, must be used in providing career and technology education programs in grades <u>seven</u> [nine] through 12, including [or] career and technology education programs for students with disabilities, [in grades seven through 12] under Sections 29.182, 29.183, and 29.184.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
