1-9 relating to the examination requirements for mold assessors and
1-10 remediators.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 1958.105, Occupations Code, is amended
1-13 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 1958.105. EXAMINATION. (a) The department may
1-15 require that an applicant for a license pass a competency
1-16 examination to qualify for the license.

1-17 (b) If the department requires an examination, the
1-18 applicant must pass the examination with a score of 70 percent or
1-19 more.

1-20 SECTION 2. Section 1958.105, Occupations Code, as amended
1-21 by this Act, applies only to an examination completed on or after
1-22 the effective date of this Act. An examination completed before the
1-23 effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed when
1-24 the examination was completed, and the former law is continued in
1-25 effect for that purpose.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
