- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.112, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsections (a) and (d) and adding Subsections (a-1) and
- 7 (a-2) to read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as otherwise authorized by this section, a school
- 9 district may not enroll more than:
- 10 (1) 18 students in a prekindergarten class; or
- 11 (2) 22 students in a kindergarten, first, second,
- 12 third, or fourth grade class.
- 13 (a-1) For purposes of Subsection (a)(1), a student who is
- 14 eligible to participate in a school district's special education
- 15 program under Section 29.003 is counted as two students.
- 16 (a-2) A limit imposed by Subsection (a) [That limitation]
- 17 does not apply during:
- 18 (1) any 12-week period of the school year selected by
- 19 the district, in the case of a district whose average daily
- attendance is adjusted under Section 42.005(c); or
- 21 (2) the last 12 weeks of any school year in the case of
- 22 any other district.
- 23 (d) On application of a school district, the commissioner
- 24 may except the district from a [the] limit imposed by [in]

- 1 Subsection (a) if the commissioner finds the limit works an undue
- 2 hardship on the district. An exception expires at the end of the
- 3 semester for which it is granted, and the commissioner may not grant
- 4 an exception for [+
- $[\frac{1}{2}]$ more than one semester at a time.
- SECTION 2. Section 25.113(a), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A campus or district that is granted an exception under
- 9 Section 25.112(d) from class size limits shall provide written
- 10 notice of the exception to the parent of or person standing in
- 11 parental relation to each student affected by the exception. The
- 12 notice must be in conspicuous bold or underlined print and:
- 13 (1) specify the class for which an exception from \underline{a}
- 14 [the] limit imposed by Section 25.112(a) was granted;
- 15 (2) state the number of children in the class for which
- 16 the exception was granted; and
- 17 (3) be included in a regular mailing or other
- 18 communication from the campus or district, such as information sent
- 19 home with students.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning in the 2005-2006
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
