- included in the group benefits program;

- 13 (3) provider availability; and
- 14 (4) any other issue the system determines is relevant
- 15 to the continued stable and efficient operation of the group
- 16 benefits program, considering the demographic, geographic, and

- 18 (b) Not later than December 31, 2006, the Employees
