PROVISION OF SERVICE. 6 7 (a) Except as provided by this section, Section 54.252, Section 54.253, and Section 54.254, a telecommunications utility 8 that holds a certificate of convenience and necessity or a 9 certificate of operating authority shall: 10 11 (1) offer all basic local telecommunications services 12 to each customer in the utility's certificated area; and 13 (2) provide continuous and adequate service in that 14 area. Except as specifically determined otherwise by the 15 (b) commission under this subchapter or Subchapter G, the holder of a 16 certificate of convenience and necessity for an area has the 17 18 obligations of a provider of last resort regardless of whether another provider has a certificate of operating authority or 19 service provider certificate of operating authority for that area. 20 21 Notwithstanding any other provision in this title, the provider of last resort obligation may be met using any technology available. 22 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
