## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the time for responding to notice of certain sworn
- 3 complaints filed with the Texas Ethics Commission.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 571.1242(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) If the alleged violation is a Category One violation:
- 8 (1) the respondent must respond to the notice required
- 9 by Section 571.123(b) not later than the 25th [10th] business day
- 10 after the date the respondent receives the notice; and
- 11 (2) if the matter is not resolved by agreement between
- 12 the commission and the respondent before the 45th [30th] business
- day after the date the respondent receives the notice under Section
- 14 571.123(b), the commission shall set the matter for a preliminary
- 15 review hearing to be held at the next commission meeting for which
- 16 notice has not yet been posted.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a sworn complaint filed with the Texas Ethics Commission on or
- 19 after September 1, 2005. A sworn complaint filed with the Texas
- 20 Ethics Commission before September 1, 2005, is governed by the law
- 21 as it existed at the time the complaint was filed, and that law is
- 22 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
