- 2 relating to certain methods of asbestos removal.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1954, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 1954.064 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 1954.064. RULES PROHIBITING WET METHOD OF ASBESTOS
- 7 REMOVAL; STUDY; REPORT. (a) In this section, "wet method" means a
- 8 process for removing asbestos from a building by spraying areas
- 9 that contain asbestos with water before the building is destroyed
- or the asbestos is removed.
- 11 (b) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 12 Services Commission by rule shall prohibit a person from using the
- 13 wet method in an area in this state with a residential population
- 14 density that is equal to or greater than the average population
- density per square mile of an urban area in the United States as
- 16 determined by the United States Bureau of the Census.
- 17 (c) The department shall conduct a study to analyze the
- 18 effects on the health of residents in areas described by Subsection
- (b) related to a possible previous exposure to asbestos from the use
- of the wet method.
- 21 (d) The department shall report the results of the study
- 22 <u>conducted under Subsection (c) to the House Committee on Public</u>
- 23 Health, or its successor, and the Senate Committee on Health and
- 24 Human Services, or its successor.

- 1 SECTION 2. (a) The executive commissioner of the Health and
- 2 Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules required by Section
- 3 1954.064, Occupations Code, as added by this Act, not later than
- 4 January 1, 2006.
- 5 (b) The Department of State Health Services shall begin the
- 6 study required under Section 1954.064(c), Occupations Code, as
- 7 added by this Act, not later than January 1, 2006.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
