- 5 SECTION 1. Section 74.005, Government Code, is amended to

- 7 Sec. 74.005. APPOINTMENT OF REGIONAL PRESIDING JUDGES. (a)
- 8 The chief justice of the supreme court [governor, with the advice
- 9 and consent of the senate, shall appoint one judge in each
- 10 administrative region as presiding judge of the region.
- 11 (b) On the death, resignation, or expiration of the term of
- office of a presiding judge, the chief justice of the supreme court
- 13 [governor] immediately shall appoint or reappoint a presiding
- 14 judge.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 815.002(a), Government Code, is amended
- 16 to read as follows:
- 17 (a) Three members of the board of trustees are appointed
- 18 with the advice and consent of the senate as follows [, one each
- 19 <del>by</del>]:
- 20 (1) <u>two members appointed by</u> the governor; <u>and</u>
- 21 (2) [the chief justice of the Supreme Court of Texas;
- 22 <del>and</del>
- 23  $\left[\frac{(3)}{3}\right]$  one member appointed by the speaker of the house
- 24 of representatives.

- 2 815.002, Government Code, does not affect the term of a person
- 3 appointed under those sections before the effective date of this
- 4 Act.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
