- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 44.0012 to read as follows:
- 7 Section 44.0012. DISTRICT FINANCIAL OFFICER. (a) Except
- 8 as provided by subsection (b), the district employee responsible
- 9 for the fiscal management of the school district shall complete a
- 10 professional certification course that teaches professional
- 11 business practices <u>and provides recognized standards of</u>
- 12 professional competence for school business administrators,
- officials, and specialists in the state of Texas.
- 14 (b) An employee who is a certified public accountant under
- 15 Chapter 901 of the Occupations Code is exempt from the requirements
- 16 of this section.
- 17 (c) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- implement this section.
- 19 SECTION 2. No later than January 1, 2006, the Texas
- 20 Education Agency shall provide a list of approved certification
- 21 courses. A school district financial officer employed by a school
- 22 district on or before January 1, 2006 must complete the
- certification course by July 1, 2005.
- SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-2007

- 2 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
