## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the assignment of students to classroom teachers.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 28.0216 to read as follows:
6	Section 28.0216. LIMITS ON ASSIGNMENT OF STUDENTS TO
7	TEACHERS. (a) A student in grades Kindergarten through 6 may not
8	be assigned for two consecutive school years to a teacher who:
9	(1) has less than one year of teaching experience; or
10	(2) does not hold the appropriate certificate issued
11	by the State Board for Educator Certification.
12	(b) In a subject for which a student takes an assessment
13	under Section 39.023(a) or (c), a student in grade 7 or higher may
14	not be assigned for two consecutive school years to a teacher who:
15	(1) has less than one year of teaching experience; or
16	(2) does not hold the appropriate certificate issued
17	by the State Board for Educator Certification.
18	SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
19	school year.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
