(a) The commission by 11 12 rule shall require a law enforcement agency of a political subdivision that employs a school resource officer or a school 13 14 district that employs a school district peace officer under Section 37.081, Education Code, to provide the officer with a training 15 16 program that meets the requirements of this section. (b) The training program must include a curriculum that 17 18 incorporates learning objectives developed by the commission regarding discipline management practices or behavior management 19 practices that are consistent with Section 37.0021, Education Code, 20 21 and the procedures adopted under that section. 22 SECTION 3. (a) The Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Standards and Education shall develop the curriculum for the 23 training program required under Section 1701.604, Occupations 24

2 (b) Notwithstanding Section 1701.604, Occupations Code, as 3 added by this Act, a school resource officer or school district 4 peace officer is not required to comply with the training 5 requirements of that section before September 1, 2006.
