13	more than 200,000, other than a county to which Subsection (a)
14	applies, may create a civil service system in accordance with
15	<u>Section 158.0335.</u>
16	SECTION 2. The heading to Section 158.033, Local Government
17	Code, is amended to read as follows:
18	Sec. 158.033. PETITION AND ELECTION <u>IN COUNTY WITH</u>
19	POPULATION OF MORE THAN 500,000.
20	SECTION 3. Section 158.033, Local Government Code, is
21	amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to
22	read as follows:
23	(a) If at least 20 percent of the employees of <u>a sheriff's</u>
24	department eligible to create a civil service system [an eligible

department] under <u>Section 158.032(a)</u> [this subchapter] sign a petition requesting an election under this section and present the petition to the county judge of the employing county, the judge shall order a departmental election on the question of the creation of a sheriff's department civil service system.

6 <u>(e) If a majority of the employees voting at an election</u> 7 <u>approve the creation of a sheriff's department civil service</u> 8 <u>system, the commissioners court shall order the creation of the</u> 9 <u>system in accordance with this subchapter.</u>

10 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 158, Local Government 11 Code, is amended by adding Section 158.0335 to read as follows:

Sec. 158.0335. PETITION AND ADOPTION OR ELECTION IN CERTAIN 12 COUNTIES WITH A POPULATION OF MORE THAN 200,000. (a) If a majority 13 14 of the employees of a sheriff's department eligible to create a 15 civil service system under Section 158.032(b) sign a petition requesting the adoption of a civil service system for the sheriff's 16 17 department, the commissioners court, within 30 days of the date the commissioners court receives the petition, shall by order create a 18 19 civil service system in accordance with this subchapter or order an election to determine whether a civil service system should be 20 21 created in the county.

- (b) An election ordered under this section must be held on the first date prescribed by Chapter 41, Election Code, that occurs after the date the commissioners court orders the election and that allows sufficient time to comply with other requirements of law.
 (c) The ballot for an election ordered under this section
- 27 shall be printed to allow voting for or against the proposition:

3	(d) An election called under this section must be held and
4	the returns prepared and canvassed in conformity with the Election
5	<u>Code.</u>
6	(e) If an election authorized under this section is held,
7	the commissioners court must order the creation of a civil service
8	system in accordance with this chapter if a majority of the votes
9	cast at the election favor the proposition.
10	(f) If an election authorized under this section is held,
11	the employees of the sheriff's department may not submit a petition
12	under Subsection (a) before the second anniversary of the date of
13	the election.
14	SECTION 5. Section 158.034(a), Local Government Code, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	(a) In a county with a population of less than 2.8 million
17	that has adopted [, if a majority of the employees voting at the
18	election approve the creation of] a sheriff's department civil
19	service system under this subchapter, the sheriff, commissioners
20	court, and district attorney shall each appoint one person to serve
21	as a member of the civil service commission that administers the
22	system. In a county with a population of 2.8 million or more that
23	has adopted [, if a majority of the employees voting at the election
24	approve the creation of] a sheriff's department civil service
25	system <u>under this subchapter</u> , the sheriff, commissioners court, and
26	district attorney shall each appoint two persons to serve as
27	members of the civil service commission that administers the

1 system, and the three appointing authorities shall appoint one 2 member by joint action requiring the affirmative vote of each of the 3 authorities.

4 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
