- 2 relating to establishing a pilot program to provide nutritional 3 supplements and products to certain elderly persons.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 161, Human Resources Code, 6 is amended by adding Section 161.074 to read as follows:
- 7 <u>Sec. 161.074.</u> <u>SENIOR NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PILOT PROGRAM.</u>
- 8 (a) The executive commissioner by rule shall develop and the
- 9 department shall implement a pilot program, to be known as the
- 10 Senior Nutrition Assistance Pilot Program (SNAPP), to provide
- 11 nutritional supplements and products to elderly persons to improve
- 12 and maintain their health.
- (b) The executive commissioner shall establish eligibility
- 14 criteria for participation in the program.
- 15 (c) In developing the pilot program, the executive
- 16 commissioner shall consult with the department, the Department of
- 17 State Health Services, and local community health centers.
- (d) The department shall operate the pilot program in at
- 19 least two counties, one of which must be in a primarily rural area
- 20 and one of which must have a population of less than 1.4 million and
- 21 in which a municipality with a population of more than one million
- 22 is located.

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- (e) The department may seek and accept gifts, grants, and
- 24 donations of funds or property from public or private sources to

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- 1 <u>develop</u> and implement the pilot program.
- 2 (f) Not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year, the
- 3 <u>department shall submit a report concerning the effectiveness of</u>
- 4 the pilot program to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of
- 5 the house of representatives, and the presiding officer of each
- 6 house and senate standing committee having jurisdiction over health
- 7 and human services issues.
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
