A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to public school staff development requirements for
- 3 teachers.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Education Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 21.4511 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 21.4511. STAFF DEVELOPMENT PROVIDED FOR TEACHERS. (a)
- 8 The staff development provided by a school district for a teacher
- 9 must be appropriate for the teacher's subject area and grade level
- 10 of instruction.
- 11 (b) The number of staff development days required for a
- 12 teacher with seven or more years of teaching experience must be
- 13 lower than the number of days required for a teacher with less than
- 14 seven years of experience.
- 15 (c) A school district shall dedicate one staff development
- 16 day each school year to informing teachers of existing education
- 17 laws and rules, including laws and rules that relate to rights of
- 18 <u>teachers.</u>
- 19 (d) A school district shall periodically provide a
- 20 <u>substitute teacher as the district determines necessary to allow a</u>
- 21 teacher to:
- 22 (1) visit other classrooms to share ideas on improving
- 23 classroom management or instruction;
- 24 (2) coordinate common planning days with teachers

- 1 teaching at the same grade level; and
- 2 (3) attend a monthly planning day, organized by grade
- 3 level and subject, to maintain consistency in curriculum and
- 4 instruction in the subject.
- 5 (e) A school district must include time spent by a teacher
- 6 participating in the following activities when determining whether
- 7 <u>a teacher has completed the minimum number of hours of staff</u>
- 8 development required by the district:
- 9 (1) staff development programs attended on weekends,
- 10 between semesters, and in the summer, if related to the teacher's
- 11 subject area of instruction and approved by a department director
- or other appropriate person, as determined by the district;
- 13 (2) on-campus meetings and release days used to
- 14 discuss student achievement, curriculum, and instruction; and
- 15 (3) involvement in an activity described by Subsection
- 16 (d).
- 17 (f) To the extent of a conflict between this section and
- 18 Section 21.451, this section prevails.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
