## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 531.081 and 531.082 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.081. STATE MEDICAID DENTAL SERVICES ADVISORY
8	COMMITTEE. (a) The executive commissioner shall establish a
9	Medicaid dental services advisory committee to:
10	(1) receive recommendations and relevant information
11	from regional Medicaid dental services committees created under
12	Section 531.082, recipient advocacy groups, and local clinics; and
13	(2) advise the executive commissioner on policy,
14	rules, and services relating to dental services provided under the
15	Medicaid program.
16	(b) The committee consists of 11 members appointed by the
17	executive commissioner from geographically diverse areas as
18	follows:
19	(1) eight dentists participating in the Medicaid
20	program; and
21	(2) three representatives of advocacy groups for
22	Medicaid dental services recipients.
23	(c) The committee shall:
24	(1) solicit recommendations and relevant information

- 13 for serving on the committee and may not be reimbursed for travel
- 14 expenses incurred while conducting the business of the committee.
- (e) The commission shall provide administrative support,
- including staff, for the committee.
- 17 (f) The committee is not subject to Chapter 2110.
- 18 Sec. 531.082. REGIONAL MEDICAID DENTAL SERVICES
- 19 COMMITTEES. (a) The executive commissioner shall establish a
- 20 regional Medicaid dental services committee in each of the public
- 21 health regions established under Section 121.007, Health and Safety
- 22 Code. A regional committee shall provide recommendations to the
- 23 <u>state Medicaid dental services advisory committee regarding dental</u>
- 24 services provided under the Medicaid program based on
- 25 recommendations from participating dentists and local clinics.
- 26 (b) Each regional committee consists of seven members
- 27 appointed by the executive commissioner as follows:

- 5 <u>(c)</u> Each regional committee shall:

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- (1) review all current Medicaid dental services

  policies that affect the region, including policies relating to

  provider audits and the resolution of issues identified through an

  audit;

- 12 (3) recommend procedures to be used with pricing

- 16 <u>(d) A member of a regional committee may not receive</u>
  17 <u>compensation for serving on the committee and may not be reimbursed</u>

- 20 (e) A regional committee is not subject to Chapter 2110.
  - SECTION 2. (a) Not later than January 1, 2006, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall appoint the state Medicaid dental services advisory committee required by Section 531.081, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 25 (b) Not later than March 1, 2006, the executive commissioner 26 of the Health and Human Services Commission shall appoint the 27 regional Medicaid dental services committees required by Section

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- 1 531.082, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
