- 14 develop and implement a maintenance program to assist counties
- 15 receiving money under the preservation program in continuing to
- 16 maintain, repair, and preserve the courthouses. The maintenance
- 17 program may include offering to periodically inspect the
- 18 courthouses and offering counties technical assistance and
- 19 information on best practices in maintaining the courthouses.
- (h) The commission shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 21 the historic courthouse preservation and maintenance programs
- $[\frac{program}{a}].$
- SECTION 3. Sections 442.0083(e) and (f), Government Code,
- 24 are amended to read as follows:

## H.B. No. 2902

- 1 (e) A grant for a historic courthouse project may not exceed 2 the greater of \$6 [\$4] million or two percent of the amount 3 appropriated for implementing the historic courthouse preservation 4 program during the state fiscal biennium.
- (f) Biennial appropriations to the commission for administering the historic courthouse preservation and maintenance programs [program] during a state fiscal biennium, including providing oversight for historic courthouse projects, may not exceed 2-1/2 [one] percent of the amount appropriated for implementing the historic courthouse preservation and maintenance programs [program] during the state fiscal biennium.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
