10 SECTION 9. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a 11 case that is pending or filed on or after the effective date of this 12 Act.

13 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it 14 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each 15 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. 16 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate 17 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
