A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1  
2 relating to the jurisdiction of the district courts in Nueces  
3 County to receive guilty pleas in and dispose of certain  
4 misdemeanor cases.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 24.130, Government Code, is amended by  
7 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

8 (d) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
9 28th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
10 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
11 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
12 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
13 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
14 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
15 pending in the district court.

16 SECTION 2. Section 24.196, Government Code, is amended by  
17 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

18 (d) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
19 94th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
20 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
21 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
22 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
23 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
24 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were

1 pending in the district court.

2 SECTION 3. Section 24.207, Government Code, is amended by  
3 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

4 (d) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
5 105th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
6 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
7 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
8 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
9 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
10 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
11 pending in the district court.

12 SECTION 4. Section 24.219, Government Code, is amended by  
13 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:

14 (d) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
15 117th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
16 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
17 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
18 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
19 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
20 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
21 pending in the district court.

22 SECTION 5. Section 24.353, Government Code, is amended by  
23 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

24 (c) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
25 148th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
26 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
27 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County

1 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
2 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
3 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
4 pending in the district court.

5 SECTION 6. Section 24.393, Government Code, is amended by  
6 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

7 (c) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
8 214th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
9 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
10 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
11 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
12 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
13 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
14 pending in the district court.

15 SECTION 7. Section 24.493, Government Code, is amended to  
16 read as follows:

17 Sec. 24.493. 347TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (NUECES COUNTY). (a)  
18 The 347th Judicial District is composed of Nueces County.

19 (b) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
20 347th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
21 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
22 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
23 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
24 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
25 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
26 pending in the district court.

27 SECTION 8. Section 24.627, Government Code, is amended by

1 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

2 (c) In addition to other jurisdiction provided by law, the  
3 319th District Court has concurrent jurisdiction with the county  
4 courts at law in Nueces County to receive a guilty plea in a  
5 misdemeanor case pending in a county court at law in Nueces County  
6 and dispose of the case, regardless of whether the case is  
7 transferred to the district court. The judgment, order, or action  
8 of the district court is valid and binding as if the case were  
9 pending in the district court.

10 SECTION 9. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a  
11 case that is pending or filed on or after the effective date of this  
12 Act.

13 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect immediately if it  
14 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each  
15 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.  
16 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate  
17 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
