1-8 relating to filing requirements for certain candidates for the
1-9 board of trustees of a junior college district.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 130.044, Education Code, is amended by
1-12 adding Subsection (g) to read as follows:

1-13 (g) The board of trustees of a district with a population
1-14 greater than one million may require that an application filed
1-15 under Subsection (d) be accompanied by a filing fee not to exceed
1-16 \$200 as determined by the board or, instead of the filing fee, a
1-17 petition signed by a number of registered voters of the district not
1-18 to exceed 200 as determined by the board.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
