- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 42, Local Government Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 42.027 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.027. TRANSFER OF EXTRATERRITORIAL JURISDICTION IN
- 8 GENERAL. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), a municipality
- 9 may transfer any part of the area of the municipality's
- 10 extraterritorial jurisdiction to another municipality adjacent to
- 11 the area. The transfer must be made by a written agreement between
- 12 the municipalities.

- (b) If the area to be transferred is not located in
- 14 proximity to the receiving municipality as provided by Section
- 15 42.021, the transfer may not be made unless each municipality that
- is located in proximity to the area as provided by Section 42.021
- declines to accept the area in its extraterritorial jurisdiction.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
