14	only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
15	Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
16	the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs
17	before that date.
18	(b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
19	Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was
20	committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
21	purpose.
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
