4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Title 6, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 151 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 151. PROHIBITION ON LAWSUIT ADVANCE FUNDING
8	FOR USURIOUS INTEREST
9	Sec. 151.001. PROHIBITION ON LAWSUIT ADVANCE FUNDING FOR
10	USURIOUS INTEREST. (a) All funding advanced to a person whose
11	repayment is contingent upon the person's recovery in a lawsuit is a
12	loan subject to the usurious interest prohibition in Section
13	302.001, Finance Code, and the penalties prescribed by Chapter 305,
14	Finance Code. A contract to provide such funding that allows a rate
15	of return in excess of the usurious interest prohibition in Section
16	302.001, Finance Code, is against the public policy of this state.
17	(b) This section does not apply to contracts entered into
18	between an attorney and a client for the purpose of compensating the
19	attorney for providing legal services.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. This
21	section applies to any case in which a final judgment is signed or
22	subject to appeal on or after the effective date of this Act.
