- (a) A state agency must use a public junior college to provide any 20

- SECTION 3. Section 656.049, Government Code, as amended by 3
- 4 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into on or after the
- effective date of this Act. A contract entered into before the 5
- effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect when the 6
- contract was entered into, and the former law is continued in effect 7
- 8 for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 9
