- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 711.002(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Unless a decedent has left directions in writing for the
- 8 disposition of the decedent's remains as provided in Subsection
- 9 (g), the following persons, in the priority listed, have the right
- 10 to control the disposition, including cremation, of the decedent's
- 11 remains, shall inter the remains, and are liable for the reasonable
- 12 cost of interment:
- 13 (1) the person designated in a written instrument
- 14 signed by the decedent;
- 15 (2) the decedent's surviving spouse;
- 16 (3) any one of the decedent's surviving adult
- 17 children;
- 18 (4) [either one of] the decedent's surviving mother
- 19 and father, other than a person whose parental rights have been
- 20 terminated [parents];
- 21 (5) any one of the decedent's surviving adult
- 22 siblings; or
- 23 (6) any adult person in the next degree of kinship in
- the order named by law to inherit the estate of the decedent.
