A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the designation of the structure on Spur 366 connecting  
3 the east and west levee of the Trinity River as the Margaret Hunt  
4 Hill Bridge.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
7 is amended by adding Section 225.059 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 225.059. MARGARET HUNT HILL BRIDGE. (a) The structure  
9 on Spur 366 located in the city of Dallas connecting the east and  
10 west levee of the Trinity River is designated as the Margaret Hunt  
11 Hill Bridge.

12 (b) The department shall design and construct markers  
13 indicating the highway number, the designation as the Margaret Hunt  
14 Hill Bridge, and any other appropriate information.

15 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the department  
16 shall erect a marker at each end of the structure.

17 (d) The department is not required to design, construct, or  
18 erect a marker under this section unless a grant or donation of  
19 private funds is made to the department to cover the cost of the  
20 design, construction, and erection of the marker.

21 (e) Money received under Subsection (d) shall be deposited  
22 to the credit of the state highway fund.

23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
