15	be eliminated because of the proposed action; and		
16	(3) the economic impact to the local community in the

18	(b) After the governor receives the notice required under		
19	Subsection (a), the governor shall prepare and fund an economic		
20	development plan for the local community in the service region in		
21	which the proposed action is to occur. The program may include
