## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the exemption from the permitting requirements of the

Texas Commission on Environmental Quality of certain municipal

solid waste management facilities that are used in the transfer of

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 7

- SECTION 1. Section 361.111(a), Health and Safety Code, as 8
- added by Section 5, Chapter 802, Section 2.08, Chapter 899, and 9
- Section 10, Chapter 1045, Acts of the 73rd Legislature, Regular 10
- Session, 1993, is reenacted and amended to read as follows: 11
- 12 The commission shall exempt from permit requirements a
- 13 municipal solid waste management facility that is used in the
- 14 transfer of municipal solid waste to a solid waste processing or
- disposal facility from: 15
- (1) a municipality with a population of less than 16
- 50,000; 17
- 18 a county with a population of less than 85,000; (2)
- a facility used in the transfer of municipal solid 19
- waste that transfers or will transfer 125 tons a day or less; or 20
- 21 a materials recovery facility, other than a grease
- 22 trap waste or grit trap waste recycling facility, that recycles for
- 23 reuse more than 10 percent of its incoming nonsegregated waste
- 24 stream if the remaining nonrecyclable waste is transferred to a

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- 1 permitted Type I landfill not farther than 50 miles from the
- 2 materials recovery facility.
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
