A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to parking of a motor vehicle operated by or for the 3 transportation of a person with a disability; providing penalties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 469, Government Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 469.0525 to read as follows:
- Sec. 469.0525. STUDY. After the publication of a federal census, the commission shall revise the standards, specifications,
- 9 and other rules required by this chapter relating to parking of a
- motor vehicle operated by or for the transportation of a person with
- 11 a disability.

- SECTION 2. Section 504.201, Transportation Code, is amended
- 13 by adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 14 (h) The department by rule shall develop and implement a
- two-tiered license plate system similar to the two-tiered parking
- 16 placard system in Section 681.002.
- 17 SECTION 3. Section 681.009, Transportation Code, is amended
- 18 to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 681.009. DESIGNATION OF PARKING SPACES [BY POLITICAL
- 20 SUBDIVISION OR PRIVATE PROPERTY OWNER]. (a) This state, a [A]
- 21 political subdivision of this state, and each other [or a] person
- 22 who owns or controls property used for parking <u>shall</u> [may]
- 23 designate one or more parking spaces or a parking area for the
- 24 exclusive use of vehicles transporting persons with disabilities.

(b) This state, a [A] political subdivision of this state, and each other person who owns or controls property used for parking must designate a parking space or area by conforming to the standards and specifications adopted by the Texas Commission of Licensing and Regulation under Section 469.052, Government Code [5(i), Article 9102, Revised Statutes], relating to the identification and dimensions of parking spaces for persons with disabilities. [A person who owns or controls private property used for parking may designate a parking space or area without conforming to those standards and specifications, unless required to conform by law.]

- (c) [A political subdivision may require a private property owner or a person who controls property used for parking:
- [(1) to designate one or more parking spaces or a
 parking area for the exclusive use of vehicles transporting persons
 with disabilities; or
- [(2) to conform to the standards and specifications
 referred to in Subsection (b) when designating a parking space or
 area for persons with disabilities.
- [(d)] The department shall provide at cost a design and stencil for use by this state, a political subdivision of this state, or another person who owns or controls property used for parking to designate spaces as provided by this section.
 - (d) At [(e) A private property owner or private person who controls property used for parking and who designates one or more uncovered parking spaces for the exclusive use of vehicles transporting persons with disabilities shall assign at] least half

- of the [those] spaces designated under this section shall be 1 assigned for the exclusive use of vehicles displaying a white on 2 blue shield disabled parking placard, except that if an odd number 3 of spaces is designated, only the number of spaces that is the 4 largest whole number less than half of the number of designated 5 6 spaces must be assigned for the exclusive use of vehicles 7 displaying a white on blue shield placard. Van-accessible parking 8 spaces shall be counted as assigned spaces under this subsection. 9 These assigned spaces must be the spaces located closest to an accessible route to an entrance accessible to a person with a 10 disability. The remaining designated parking spaces may be used by 11 vehicles displaying a white on blue shield disabled parking 12 placard, a white on red shield disabled parking placard, or white on 13 red shield license plates issued under Section 504.201 [502.253]. 14 15 [This subsection applies only to a property used for parking that serves a building or other facility: 16 [(1) that state law requires to be accessible

- SECTION 4. Sections 681.011(a), (b), 22 and (m), Transportation Code, are amended to conform to the repeal of 23 24 Sections 502.253 and 502.254 of that code and the enactment of 25 Sections 504.201 and 504.202 of that code by Chapter 1320, Acts of the 78th Legislature, Regular Session, 2003, and further amended to 26 read as follows: 27

- 2 (1) the person stands a vehicle on which are displayed
- 3 license plates issued under Section 504.201 [502.253] or 504.202
- 4 [502.254] or a disabled parking placard in a parking space or area
- 5 designated specifically for persons with disabilities, including a

- 8 [(B)] a person who owns or controls private
- 9 property used for parking as to which a political subdivision has
- 10 provided for the application of this section under Subsection (f);

- or area is not authorized by Section 681.006, 681.007, or 681.008.
- 14 (b) A person commits an offense if the person:
- 15 (1) stands a vehicle on which license plates issued
- 16 under Section 504.201 [502.253] or 504.202 [502.254] are not
- 17 displayed and a disabled parking placard is not displayed in a
- 18 parking space or area designated specifically for individuals with
- 19 disabilities, including a parking space or area designated by [÷
- 20 [(A) a political subdivision; or
- 21 [(B)] a person who owns or controls private
- 22 property used for parking as to which a political subdivision has
- 23 provided for the application of this section under [this]
- 24 Subsection (f); or
- 25 (2) stands a vehicle displaying a white on red shield
- 26 disabled parking placard or white on red shield license plates
- issued under Section 504.201 [502.253] in a space designated under

- 1 Section 681.009(d) [681.009(e)] for the exclusive use of vehicles
- 2 displaying a white on blue shield disabled parking placard or
- 3 license plate.
- 4 (1) $\left[\frac{m}{m}\right]$ A person commits an offense if the person:
- 5 (1) stands a vehicle on which are displayed license
- 6 plates issued under Section 504.201 [502.253] or a disabled parking
- 7 placard in a parking space or area for which this chapter creates an
- 8 exemption from payment of a fee or penalty imposed by a governmental
- 9 unit;
- 10 (2) does not have a disability;
- 11 (3) is not transporting a person with disability; and
- 12 (4) does not pay any applicable fee related to
- 13 standing in the space or area imposed by a governmental unit or
- 14 exceeds a limitation on the length of time for standing in the space
- 15 or area.
- 16 SECTION 5. Not later than January 1, 2007, the Texas
- 17 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall:
- 18 (1) complete a study to determine the population in
- 19 this state of persons with disabilities; and
- 20 (2) use the results of the study to establish the
- 21 standards, specifications, and other rules required by Chapter 469,
- Government Code, relating to parking of a motor vehicle operated by
- or for the transportation of a person with a disability.
- 24 SECTION 6. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 25 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 26 Act. For purposes of this section, an offense is committed before
- 27 the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurs

- before the effective date.
- 2 (b) This Act applies only to a license plate for persons
- 3 with disabilities for which an application is submitted on or after
- 4 the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
