H.B. No. 3102

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the employment recruitment and retention of physicians
3 by rural hospitals.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Chapter 162, Occupations Code is amended by
6 amending Section 162.001(c) to read as follows:

7 (c) The board shall certify a health organization to
8 contract with or employ physicians licensed by the board if the
9 organization:

10 (1) is a nonprofit corporation under the Texas
11 Non-Profit Corporation Act (Article 1396-1.01 et seq., Vernon's
12 Texas Civil Statutes) and Section 501(c)(3), Internal Revenue Code
13 of 1986 (26 U.S.C. Sec. 501(c)(3)); and or,

14 (2) a hospital located in a county with a population of
15 50,00 or less; or designated as a critical access hospital under the
16 authority of and in compliance with 42 U.S.C. Section 1395i-4 or as
17 a sole community hospital under the authority of and in compliance
18 with 42 U.S.C. Section 1395ww(d)(5)(D)(iii).

19 (3) [~~(2)~~] is organized and operated as:

20 (A) a migrant, community, or homeless health
21 center under the authority of and in compliance with 42 U.S.C.
22 Section 254b or 254c; or

23 (B) a federally qualified health center under 42
24 U.S.C. Section 1396d(1)(2)(B).

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
